Day 1

Arrival in Cairo with Dinner Cruise

Following your meal, embark on a scenic 50-minute drive (about 40 km south of Cairo) to Saqqara to see the Step Pyramid of Zoser, the world's oldest major stone structure built around 2630 BC for King Djoser.

Wrap up your day with a comfortable flight ride to your hotel in Aswan, reflecting on the wonders and history you experienced today.

Day 3

Explore the Attractions of Aswan - Overnight onboard the Cruise

After your tour, transfer to your desert camp for a relaxed dinner and an overnight stay under the starlit sky.

Day 12

Explore Petra



After breakfast at the camp, embark on a scenic 1.5-hour drive to the red rose city of Petra, Jordan's most captivating attraction. Established around the 6th century B.C. by the ingenious Nabataean Arabs, Petra once flourished as a vital commercial hub extending into Syria.

Guided by an expert, traverse the narrow, dramatic Siq, a natural canyon leading to the breathtaking Treasury carved into the rock. Continue along the ancient Street of Facades to admire the Royal Tombs and the formidable Pharaoh's Castle.

Enjoy a delicious lunch at a local restaurant, savoring traditional Jordanian flavors, before your guide bids you farewell at the restaurant area. You'll then have free time to explore Petra at your leisure, perhaps venturing up the 800 steps to the impressive Monastery El Deir. Overnight in Petra.

Day 13

Witness Kerak Castle - Dead Sea Beach



After breakfast, set off for Kerak to visit the famous Crusader castle built in 1132/34 by King Baldwin I of Jerusalem. Marvel at its formidable structure and rich history.

Next, drive to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. Enjoy some leisure time on the beach, experience the buoyancy of the salty waters and the therapeutic benefits of the dark mud for your skin. Savor a delicious lunch at a local beachside eatery, then relax with access to showers and locker rooms.

Finally, continue to Amman where you'll check into your hotel for an overnight stay in the heart of the city.

Day 14

Explore the Gems of Amman City



Begin your day with a hearty breakfast at your hotel before embarking on an engaging tour of Jordan's vibrant capital, Amman, historically known as Rabbath Ammon.

Explore downtown where modern life meets ancient history. Start at the Citadel, where you can admire remnants from the Roman to early Islamic periods, then visit the Archaeological Museum to delve deeper into the region's heritage.

Enjoy a delicious lunch in the city, sampling local flavors that complement your cultural journey. Continue your exploration with a stroll through the bustling Souq, and marvel at the impressive 2nd-century Roman Theatre, once seating 6,000 spectators. Return to your hotel in Amman for a comfortable overnight stay.
